

Important Dates for Student Employment – Summer 2024

Date	Significant Event
May 8 – May 24	<p>Semester Interim</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Student employees may work up to 28 hours per week. - Check with your org owner before increasing student workloads
May 17	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - End of spring semester student employment - All student employment is terminated as of this date. - Work-study employees who are not continuing at RRCC after spring may not work after May 7th.
May 18	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - First day of summer semester student employment - All new and returning students must be registered for six credit hours in the summer academic semester to be eligible for student employment. - Student employees registered for fall semester courses only (without summer registration) will be required to contribute to a TIAA IRA. - Beginning of summer semester work-study eligibility. Students must have a minimum of 6 credit hours, as well as work-study eligibility, in spring, summer, and fall semesters. <p>Contact the Financial Aid Office for details – 303.914.6256 or rrcc.financialaid@rrcc.edu</p>
May 25 – May 27	<p>Memorial Day</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - No Classes, both campuses closed. - No work-study and student hourly allowed.
May 28	<p>All student employees must return to 20 hours per week</p>
May 28	<p>Full Term 10-week sessions begin</p>
June 19	<p>Juneteenth</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Both campuses are closed. - No work-study or student hourly allowed.
July 4	<p>Independence Day Holiday</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Both Campuses Closed. - No work-study or student hourly allowed.
July 5	<p>HR and Financial Aid begins accepting fall semester renewal and new hire forms</p>
July 26	<p>All Summer student employment ends.</p>
July 27	<p>Beginning of fall semester student employment.</p>
July 27 - August 16	<p>Semester Interim</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Student employees may work up to 28 hours per week. - Check with your org owner before increasing student workloads
August 19	<p>Fall Semester Begins</p>
