- Copy of your passport identification page(s). Include passports for all dependents.

- Original and current Letter of Government Sponsorship (if your education expenses will be paid by your government).

Required if you are transferring your I-20 from another U.S. school:

- A completed RRCC transfer-in form indicating your transfer release date upon acceptance to RRCC.

The U.S.A. government does not allow F-1 students to work off-campus and on-campus job opportunities are limited, so employment cannot be relied upon for financial support.
