



Concurrent Enrollment-Campus Select

Concurrent Enrollment is a high school program that allows high school students in 9th-12th grade to take college classes for high school and college credit. Under Concurrent Enrollment, the college tuition may be paid by your school district upon approval from the high school principal. To get started, follow the steps below:

STEP 1: TALK TO YOUR HIGH SCHOOL COUNSELOR

- Upon approval from your high school, you may take course work at Red Rocks through Concurrent Enrollment. Ask your counselor about Concurrent Enrollment and visit: <https://www.cde.state.co.us/concurrentenrollment>

STEP 2: FILL OUT THE REQUIRED PAPERWORK

- Complete the Concurrent Enrollment Agreement and get signatures from your high school in Sections C&D
- Read and sign the Student Payment Agreement with a parent.
- Underage Student/Parent Consent Form (students under 17 years old only)
- Copy of high School Transcript (new students under 16 years old only)
- Letter of Recommendation from counselor (new students under 16 years old only)

STEP 3: FILL OUT THE APPLICATIONS at: WWW.RRCC.EDU/APPLY-NOW

- Complete the free Red Rocks Community College Application for Admission and College Opportunity Fund Applications. You will be issued a RRCC Student ID number when completed.

STEP 4: COMPLETE RRCC ONLINE ORIENTATION

- Mandatory online orientation is designed to provide recently-admitted students (both new and returning) with an introduction (or re-introduction) to Red Rocks Community College procedures, academic programs, and student services. You will be directed to Orientation once you have completed the RRCC application.

STEP 5: SATISFY ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS

Submit test scores or your high school transcript. If your scores are equal or higher, you are eligible to take college level academic courses. (See chart below):

Or, you can participate in one of the following placement methods:

- Take the free Accuplacer Assessment. The Accuplacer measures your readiness for college level coursework.
- Take the free Self-Guided Assessments. Determine the appropriate levels of coursework that align with your personal educational goals, skills and abilities.

STEP 6: COMPLETE REGISTRATION
