This EMT program has been tailored with ski patrollers in mind and is structured to accommodate summer employment. It is important to note that this opportunity is open to all interested individuals.

The curriculum will encompass all the essential elements of our standard EMT program while delving deeper into topics such as:

- ❄ environmental emergencies
- ❄ altitude emergencies
- ❄ water-related emergencies
- ❄ and other situations commonly encountered in outdoor settings

The skills students will acquire will be particularly relevant for those working in mountainous environments, including techniques like boot removal, addressing challenges posed by winter clothing, exploring alternative splinting methods, and learning effective packaging methods, among others.
