call-n-Ride Connects You to Your Community

The RTD call-n-Ride is a curb-to-curb transportation service that takes you anywhere you want to go within a designated service area.

Service area boundaries for the Arvada call-n-Ride are I-70/I-76 on the south; Ward Road on the west; Sheridan Boulevard and Marshall Street on the east; 64th Avenue, 68th Avenue and 72nd Avenue on the north.

You can use call-n-Ride to get to work, school, shopping or to connect with other RTD bus routes.



Making it Easy

- Service is available on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Drivers may combine individual trip requests to create shared rides. Drivers will provide passengers with an estimated time of arrival.
- The Arvada call-n-Ride area includes the Olde Town Arvada park-n-Ride and the Ward Road park-n-Ride where you can connect with Local, Express and Regional bus routes for travel throughout the metro area.

How to Use call-n-Ride

- Call the designated call-n-Ride phone number where your trip starts. The Arvada call-n-Ride phone number is **303.941.8900**.
- For same-day service, call at least one hour in advance. You can also schedule trips up to two weeks in advance.
- Recurring trips (same days and times) may be scheduled in advance with the call-n-Ride driver.
- When scheduling your trip, provide your name, date of travel, departure location, destination and desired arrival time.
- Please be ready at least five minutes before your scheduled pick-up time.
- If you need to cancel, please do so immediately.

One-way Local Cash Fares

Adult	\$ 1.75
Discount *	\$.85

*Discount fares apply to seniors (65+), individuals with disabilities, Medicare recipients and elementary, middle and high school students, ages 6-19.

Please have exact fare. Drivers do not carry or make change.

Children five years of age and under ride **FREE** and must be accompanied by a fare-paying adult (limit three children per adult).

Passes and Tickets

RTD passes and tickets are accepted on call-n-Ride.

Transfers

If you are connecting to another RTD service, ask your driver for a **FREE** transfer when you board. Use it as credit toward the fare of your connecting service.

RTD passengers ride **FREE** with a valid RTD access-a-Ride I.D. card. For more information about the access-a-Ride I.D. card, call RTD at 303.299.2960.
