REE 201 - Real Estate Brokers I (6 credits)

This course, along with REE 202, enables the student to meet the educational requirements of the Colorado Real Estate Commission for a Colorado Real Estate Brokers license, and includes Real Estate Law and Practice, Practical Applications and Current Legal Issues.

(REE 201-001 – Spring CRN 31772)

REE 202 - Real Estate Brokers II (6 credits)

This course, along with REE 201, enables the student to meet the educational requirements of the Colorado Real Estate Commission for a Colorado Real Estate Brokers license. This course includes Colorado Contracts and Regulations, Real Estate Closings, and Trust Accounts and Recordkeeping. (REE 202-001 - Spring CRN 31773)

These courses must be taken concurrently.

TUITION and FEES

Resident tuition and fees for Spring of 2012 for the 12 credits is estimated at: **\$1391.89 cost to the student**, not including books.

The actual total cost is approximately \$2135.89, but the College Opportunity Fund stipend of \$744.00 will be paid to the college by the State of Colorado on behalf of eligible Colorado residents. *All students must register for the stipend!
