CLASSICAL GUITAR:

Order from LMI,

MANDOLIN:

- Order through LMI, kit B7K "F5 style mandolin Kit", although we will be building A5 style mandolins from them. Kit includes a book and all materials necessary for the course.

VIOLIN:

- The kits can be orderd through International Violin Supply ([IVC](#)) or can be picked up at the shop by placing an order through [FOTSinc](#) (friendsoftheshop.org)
- The materials are split into two parts. Student must have initial kit by the time class starts. For the second portion, student will need to place order through IVC. There options and additional information in regards to the second portion that will be explained during class. The order for the second portion should be placed during the 6th or 7th week of class
 - Initial Kit
 - 1/4 sheets of 5/8 plywood & 1/8 masonite for the forms
 - Hide Glue - small 8 oz container of "real" hide glue - explanations of proper consistancy will be a part of class
 - Violin Parts - all material need to be music grade lumber
 - Back & Sides - Maple (5/8 x 5 x 12) tapered violin milled
 - Top - Spruce - as above
 - Neck - we'll be using a pre-carved neck for the beginning class - Maple
 - Corner & End Block - Willow 6x6x 6/4
 - finger board - Ebony 4/4 x 3 x 18
 - Sound Post - spruce
 - Bass Bar - spruce
 - Misc
 - Maple Veneer
 - Pine Veneer
 - Stained Black maple Veneer
 - Ebony Nut material
 - varnish (12oz)
 - Mid Semester Kit (more details provided during semester)
 - Order during 6th or 7th week of class
 - bridge
 - pegs
 - tail piece
 - tail piece adjuster
 - end pin
 - strings
 - chinrest and bracket
