



Red Rocks Community College Foundation Fall 2007 - Spring 2008 Scholarship Application

The Red Rocks Community College Foundation offers a wide variety of scholarships based on both need and merit. An applicant's grades, academic and professional goals, financial need, community service, and special circumstances are all evaluated in the awarding process. By filling out the Red Rocks Community College Foundation Scholarship Application, applicants apply for consideration for all of the Foundation's scholarship awards. Scholarship amounts vary, but start at \$600 per semester.

ELIGIBILITY: To be eligible to apply for RRCC Foundation Scholarships, applicants must:

1. Be a current RRCC student or be eligible for RRCC admission
2. Be a US citizen or an eligible non-citizen
3. Be a Colorado resident (PA students are exempt from this requirement)
4. Have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.0 if submitting a transcript (If a transcript is unavailable, see item 4 below)

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS: Your RRCC Foundation Scholarship Application must include:

1. Completed application form (Page 1) - PLEASE PRINT OR TYPE
2. Personal statement (Page 2)
3. Letter of recommendation or completed recommendation form (Page 3)
4. Academic record:
 - o Submit an unofficial transcript from RRCC or last school attended
 - o If home-schooled, submit SAT or ACT scores in place of transcript
 - o If a transcript is unavailable, ACCUPLACER or other assessment test scores or GED scores may be submitted in place of transcript

Deadline: Friday June 1, 2007 @ 5:00 p.m.

PLEASE NOTE: Completion of this application does not guarantee a scholarship award. All eligible applications submitted by the deadline will be evaluated on a number of criteria including need and merit. The RRCC Foundation reserves the right to extend the filing period at the discretion of the Executive Director. RRCC Foundation scholarships are funded by gifts from private donors and do not include public funds. The RRCC Foundation Executive Director has final decision-making rights regarding scholarship selections.

Red Rocks Community College Foundation Scholarship Program Policies

Withdrawal Policy: If you withdraw from any courses paid by a RRCC Foundation Scholarship, you will be expected to refund the scholarship to the Foundation within 14 days of withdrawal.

Financial Adjustments: Scholarship amounts may be adjusted based on financial need and/or additional awards.

Continuing an Award into the Spring Semester: Most RRCC Foundation Scholarships are two-semester awards (Fall and Spring). To continue an RRCC Foundation Scholarship into the Spring 2007 term, the awardee must:

- Successfully complete at least 6.0 credit hours during the Fall 2007 semester.
- Register for a minimum of 6.0 credit hours during the Spring 2008 semester.
- Attain a minimum Fall 2007 semester GPA of 2.5 (some awards require higher GPA).
