

Student Voice Grant Application 2011-2012

The Student Voice Grant provides funding for programs and projects directly benefitting a large segment of the Red Rocks Community College student body. The fund, established through the Red Rocks Community College Foundation, is designated specifically for programs and projects that **enrich the education experiences of Red Rocks students, expose students to new ideas and resources, or create an increased sense of community on campus.** RRCC students, clubs and student organizations; faculty and staff members; or departments and programs may apply for funding.

Funding Criteria:

- The program or project must have a specific budget. Please note that the **maximum grant award is \$1,000.**
- The program or project must **directly benefit a large segment of the Red Rocks student body.** If the main project occurs off-campus (e.g. attending a conference), then a presentation must be offered on campus to share the experience with a larger audience.
- The funding proposal must be submitted at least **30 days prior to the program or project.** Please note that if travel is involved, a longer timeline may be required.
