



CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT

Red Rocks Community College welcomes high school students who can benefit from our instructional programs.

To get started, follow the five simple steps below:

STEP 1: TALK TO YOUR HIGH SCHOOL COUNSELOR

- Upon approval from your high school, you may take course work at Red Rocks for dual credit (high school and college credit). Ask your counselor about Concurrent Enrollment or ASCENT programs.

STEP 2: FILL OUT THE PAPERWORK

- Complete the **Concurrent Enrollment Agreement and Registration Sheet** for the **Concurrent Enrollment Program**
- Complete the **ASCENT Agreement and Registration Sheet** for the **ASCENT program**
- **Provide your SASID number-** your high school counselor can provide you with this district ID number.

STEP 3: FILL OUT THE APPLICATIONS:

- Complete the Red Rocks Community College Application for Admission and College Opportunity Fund Application online at: www.rccc.edu/onlineenroll/

STEP 4: COMPLETE THE ASSESSMENT PROCESS

- Submit ACT or SAT scores (See Chart below):

**If your scores are equal or higher, you have no registration restrictions. If your scores are lower or you are under the age of 21 you must complete the ACCUPLACER Assessment.*

- **OR** complete the free, walk-in ACCUPLACER Assessment at the college. The ACCUPLACER measures your readiness for college level course work; it is not a test of whether or not you can attend Red Rocks, but a tool to help advisors place you in appropriate college courses.
