An applicant's grades, academic and professional goals, financial need, community service, and special circumstances are all evaluated in the awarding process. By filling out this RRCC Foundation **Internship Grant** application, applicants will be considered for internship grant awards. Grant amounts vary, but typically cover the tuition for 1-credit to 3-credit internships.

ELIGIBILITY:

To be eligible to apply for RRCC Foundation **Internship Grants**, applicants must:

1. Be a current RRCC student.
2. Be a US citizen, permanent resident or an employment-eligible non-resident.
3. Be a Colorado resident
4. Have a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or better.
5. Preference will be given to students pursuing non-paid internships, particularly in a non-profit setting.

1. Fully completed application (Page 1) – PLEASE PRINT OR TYPE
2. Personal Statement (Page 2)
3. Instructor Recommendation Form (Page 3)
4. Unofficial RRCC Transcript
