# Red Rocks Community College - Lakewood Campus Map

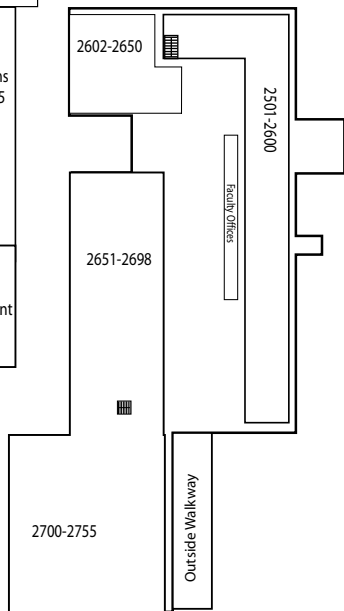

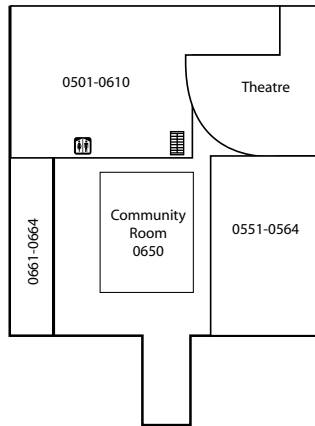

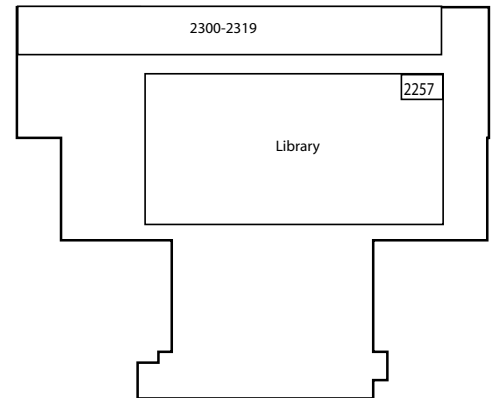
