



High School Centennial Scholarship 2008-2009

This scholarship is merit based, intended for students who have academically succeeded in high school by earning a cumulative grade point average of 3.75 or higher. If granted, the award will cover 6, 9 or 12 credit hours of tuition and student fees for one academic year. Please read the following scholarship guidelines before submitting your application.

Scholarship Guidelines

Students applying for a Red Rocks Community College scholarship must meet the following requirements and any additional criteria needed per scholarship.

- Apply for Admission to RRCC online at www.rrcc.edu (must be at least 16 years old)
- Be a Colorado resident for tuition
- Be a U.S. citizen/eligible non-citizen
- Complete a scholarship application
- * Submitting the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is highly recommended

Additional Eligibility Criteria

- Must be a graduate of the 2007-2008 academic year
- Cumulative grade point average of **3.75** or higher on a 4.0 scale (freshmen through senior year). **Attach transcript.**
- If your high school does not provide a transcript with grades, you must provide two sources of information to be considered for this scholarship:
 - ACT sub test scores with ENGL 18, READ 17, MATH 23 (for placement in College Algebra) or SAT test scores Verbal 440, MATH 460 or higher
 - Proof of a competitive process at your high school or portfolio
- Applicants must not have exceeded 24 RRCC credits prior to enrollment for the fall 2008 semester.

Additional Scholarship Information

- **Recipients of this award must maintain a 3.5 grade point average fall 2008, and complete 75% of course work attempted to receive funds for the spring 2009 semester.**
- The approximate value of the scholarship is \$96.60 per credit hour. The value of the scholarship will be determined after the state legislature sets tuition rates in summer 2007. Tuition for on-line courses is more expensive than traditional RRCC courses.
- Scholarships or financial awards issued by the College or College Foundation may be reduced if the student qualifies for a need-based financial award, according to federal or state guidelines.
- Students may only be eligible for one RRCC funded scholarship; Foundation awards excluded.
- Incomplete scholarship applications will not be considered.
- Completion of this scholarship application does not guarantee an award. All eligible scholarship applications will be reviewed after the deadline.
