



High School Senior Achievement Scholarship 2012 Application

The High School Senior Achievement Scholarship is for the high school student that has completed all of their high school requirements by December of their senior year and wants a jump-start on their college education. This scholarship covers up to 9 credit hours of tuition only for the 2013 spring semester.

Eligibility Requirements

- *Early graduation completion requirements by December 2012*
- *Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale*
- *Colorado resident for tuition, as determined by the College*
- *Application for Admission to Red Rocks Community College*
- *Be a U.S. citizen/eligible non-citizen*

Additional Guidelines

The scholarship application form along with the following information must be submitted to the High School Relations Office by December 7, 2012

- *Short essay, (min. of 100 words) typed, 12 pt. font*
- *Documentation signed by the high school counselor verifying completion of graduation requirements*
- *Copy of high school transcript*

The scholarship will pay up to 9 college credits of tuition only for spring semester enrollment. The registration fee, course fees, books and other educational expenses associated with the college courses are the responsibility of the student. This scholarship is the student's share of tuition for regular on-campus classes only and does not cover the additional charges of any online classes.

Registration Information

The following enrollment steps must be complete, prior to registering for classes:

- *Submit an Application for Admission and sign up for the College Opportunity Fund online at www.rrcc.edu/onlineenroll/*
- *Complete the Assessment Process: provide ACT or SAT test scores or take the ACCUPLACER assessment at RRCC.*
- *Meet with an Academic Advisor for course planning. Advising is available on a walk-in basis or by appointment Monday-Thursday 8:00-5:30 and Friday 9:00-4:30. You can call (303) 914-6255 to schedule an appointment with an advisor.*
