



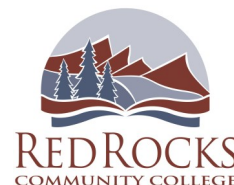

Class Room Options

Take a college preparatory class. Your Accuplacer test scores will indicate your current level of skills and knowledge and help you to know which class to take.

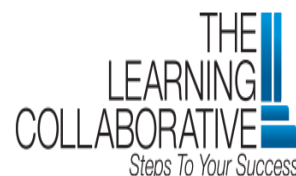
- * Classes start at 3 credits
- * Tuition is approximately \$435 (in-state tuition rate) - does not include textbooks
- * Classes typically meet 2 days a week for 15 weeks
- * Earning a grade of "C" or higher will advance you to the next level class
- * All RRCC prep classes are Financial Aid eligible



The Learning Collaborative

The Learning Collaborative is a partnership between RRCC, The Learning Source and Jefferson Count Workforce Center. The Learning Collaborative will prepare you to improve your skills and knowledge to retake the Accuplacer test, which will determine placement into RRCC preparatory classes.

- * You will work with instructors and tutors
- * The cost is \$60.00 each semester—includes workbook
- * Classes are held on:
 - * Section 001 — Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays, 9:30 to 11:30am
 - * Section 002 — Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays, 3:00 to 5:00 pm
 - * Section 003 — Mondays and Wednesdays, 6:00 to 9:00 pm
- * This option works best for students whose scores on the Accuplacer test require additional skills building in math or reading-writing
