Required if you are being sponsored by someone other than yourself:

- Affidavits of Support for Living Expenses and/ or Tuition, Books, and Health Insurance (if being supported wholly or partially by a private or company sponsor).

- □ Original and current Letter of Government Sponsorship (if your education expenses will be paid by your government).

Required if you are transferring your I-20 from another U.S. school:

- \Box Copy of your current I-20 and F-1 visa.
- □ A completed RRCC transfer-in form indicating your transfer release date upon acceptance to RRCC. This document will be given to you after we have reviewed your application. Please submit your completed application first.
