The placement test (CCPT) is an untimed multiple choice test but typically takes 3 hours. We recommend taking the tests on separate days. An appointment is advised to test and includes:

- Reading with Essay writing
- Math begins with an adaptive basic algebra test and then goes to one of the following:
 - 1 Linear Arithmetic
 - 2 Pre-Algebra
 - 3 Intermediate Algebra

– Trigonometry / Calculus is a separate test.

This assessment is an option for students getting a score of at least 60 on the Intermediate Algebra. This test is used to place students into MAT 122 College Trigonometry or MAT 125 Survey of Calculus or MAT 201 Calculus I. There are multiple free online study resources for the English CCPT.
