

Introduction to the RRCC Student Recreation Center

In the spring of 2013, Red Rocks Student Government began researching the feasibility of funding and constructing a campus Recreation Center for Red Rock's students.

When was the vote?

The planning/feasibility study including a period of student input was conducted from October 2013 – April 2014. Information on the final plan was distributed to students between April 21st and 28th, 2014. A student referendum regarding the plan/fee increase was held April 28th - May 4th, 2014.

What facilities and programs will it house? Based on student input and budget considerations design includes: gymnasium space, weight/cardiovascular area, dance/exercise studios, climbing and bouldering wall, improvements to the current multipurpose field, an outdoor fitness deck, student meeting and gathering spaces, and locker rooms.

Where will it be?

The facility will be located on the northeast corner of the main building of the Lakewood Campus.

When will it be completed?

The projected opening of the facility is currently in the spring of 2017.

Who can use the Student Recreation Center? All student fee-paying students. Employees may access it for a fee. Non-fee paying students (online students, etc.) may opt in and pay the per semester rec. center fee. At this point, the facility will not be available to the general public.

Can I use it after I graduate?

Alumni who were enrolled during any semester of 2016 (spring, summer or fall) and paid the Student Recreation Center fee of \$70.00 in spring and/or fall semesters, \$42.00 for summer semester, will be allowed access to the Student Recreation Center for all of 2017 (January through December.)

When does the rec. center fee begin and how much will it cost?

A stepped fee will be in place beginning in Spring 2016.

Construction/Bond portion:

Spring and Fall 2016 - \$70.00 per semester, Summer 2016 semester - \$42.00 per semester

Construction and Operating Fee portion:

Spring and Fall 2017, and thereafter - \$115.00 per semester, Summer 2017 semester - \$69.00 per semester
