RETEST POLICY ON THE BACK

ACCUPLACER TESTING

The Accuplacer test is used by public two- and four-year colleges and universities in Colorado to correctly place you in coursework, as you begin taking classes. If you have qualifying ACT or SAT scores from within the past five years for Reading & English and within the past two years for Math, please supply your score report and we will enter those scores for you. If you have taken qualifying college-level coursework, you need to supply a transcript to the Student Records Department to have that information reviewed.

We are required to collect the scratch paper after you complete the test.

The exam cannot be taken more than three times between census dates for the first semester of enrollment. The same day retest is not allowed according to the College Board.

The second retest can be taken one week from the original test date.

There will be a one week waiting period between the second and third retest. RRCC students will require approval from the Learning Commons or Advising (for Arvada students) for the third (final) test attempt.

Remember that you will need your Student ID number and a proper identification form to retake any part of the test.
