



Expanding Quality in Infant Toddler Care Training (EQIT)

This 48 hour training provides early childhood teachers, assistant teachers, and family child care providers with up-to-date information to enhance their work with infants and toddlers. Successful completion meets the licensing education requirement for Infant Nursery Supervisor, & the Experienced, Three under Two, and Infant/Toddler family child care homes. This training is also accepted for Director and Early Childhood Teacher Qualifications.

Topics include:

Infant and Toddler Development, Relationship Based Care, Developing Responsive Curriculums and Environments, Meeting Children's Social and Emotional Needs, Partnering with Families, Responsive Caregiving, Safe and Healthy Environments, Understanding and Respecting the Gifts of Culture, Language and Literacy, Children with Special Needs, and more!

Upon successful completion, participants will receive a certificate from the Colorado Department of Education. This course may be taken for college credit (ECE 111) through Red Rocks Community College, with additional work required.
