

Fall 2013 College Prep English and Reading Quick Reference Guide

Writing Fundamentals: ENG 060 (3 credits)

This course focuses on paragraph structure and development and introduces the formal essay. The course reviews grammar, usage, and punctuation skills while employing critical thinking strategies and the writing process to respond to a wide variety of writing situations. *Prerequisite: English 030 or equivalent assessment scores.*

Writing Fundamentals with Basic Composition: ENG 060 / ENG 090 (6 credits)

This co-requisite course combines the learning objectives of English 060 and English 090 and develops writing skills required in college classes. The course utilizes the writing process as a tool to developing clear written communication. It explores writing for specific purposes and audiences and emphasizes critical thinking strategies to summarize, respond, and analyze a variety of writing genres. Students successfully completing both sections will meet the writing prerequisites for English 121.

Prerequisite: English 030, Reading 060, or equivalent assessment scores.

Writing Fundamentals with Basic Composition and Integrated Reading: ENG 060 / ENG 090 / REA 075 (9 credits)

This co-requisite course combines the learning objectives of English 060, English 090, and College Prep Reading (REA 060/090) and develops the writing and reading skills required in college classes. The course utilizes the writing process as a tool to developing clear written communication. It explores writing for specific purposes and audiences and emphasizes critical thinking strategies to summarize, respond, and analyze a variety of writing genres and analytical reading strategies. Students successfully completing all sections will meet the writing and reading prerequisites for English 121. *Prerequisite: English 030, Reading 030, or equivalent assessment scores.*

Writing Fundamentals with Foundations of Reading: ENG 060 / REA 060 (6 credits)

This co-requisite course combines the learning objectives of English 060 and Reading 060 and develops the writing and reading skills in preparation for college courses. The course utilizes the writing process as a tool to developing clear written communication and explores a variety of texts to improve reading comprehension.

Prerequisite: English 030, Reading 030, or equivalent assessment scores.

Basic Composition: ENG 090 (3 credits)

This course emphasizes critical thinking and explores writing for specific purposes and audiences. The course develops skills required for college-level writing while reviewing paragraph structure and focusing on essay development. Hybrid Sections: 040 and 041. Online Sections: 470 and 471. *Prerequisite: English 060, Reading 060, or equivalent assessment scores.*

Basic Composition with College Preparatory Reading: ENG 090 / REA 090 (6 credits)

This co-requisite course combines the learning objectives of English 090 and Reading 090 and develops the writing and reading skills required in college courses. The course utilizes the writing process as a tool to developing clear written communication. It explores a variety of texts to improve reading comprehension and critical analysis.

Prerequisite: English 060, Reading 060, or equivalent assessment scores.

Basic Composition with English Composition I: ENG 090 / ENG 121 (6 credits)

This co-requisite course is designed around the English 121 curriculum with additional support to develop foundational writing skills. It emphasizes the planning, writing, and revising of compositions, including the development of critical and logical thinking skills. Composition assignments stress analytical, evaluative, and persuasive/argumentative writing.

Prerequisite: English 060, Reading 090, or equivalent assessment scores.

Basic Composition with English Composition I - Mainstream: ENG 090 / ENG 121 (6 credits)

This co-requisite course is designed around the English 121 curriculum. Students are enrolled in a traditional English 121 course and then meet in a smaller group for additional support to develop foundational writing skills. It emphasizes the planning, writing, and revising of compositions, including the development of critical and logical thinking skills. Composition assignments stress analytical, evaluative, and persuasive/argumentative writing. *Prerequisite: English 060, Reading 090, or equivalent assessment scores.*

Foundations of Reading: REA 060 (3 credits)

This course focuses on strategies for vocabulary development, improved reading comprehension, and enrichment.

Prerequisite: Reading 030 or equivalent assessment scores.

College Preparatory Reading: REA 090 (3 credits)

This course focuses on strategies for improving comprehension, developing vocabulary, and increasing rate for reading college textbooks. *Prerequisite: Reading 060 or equivalent assessment scores.*

Special Topics: Integrated Reading A and B: REA 075 and REA 076 (3 credits)

These courses combine the learning objectives of College Prep Reading (REA 060 / REA 090) and develop reading skills in preparation for the reading demands of college courses. They explore a variety of texts to improve reading comprehension and critical analysis. REA 075 is a co-requisite and REA 076 is an option for evening students in English 060, English 090, or an evening co-requisite course. *Prerequisite: Reading 030 or equivalent assessment scores.*

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Traditional delivery options for English 060, English 090, Reading 060, and Reading 090 are listed in the Fall 2013 Schedule.
