Once again we are overwhelmed by the commitment of our community to ensure that students have access to an affordable, high quality college education. Through your donations, volunteerism, and advocacy, we continue to provide hope for a brighter future and the opportunity to achieve it through education.

During this past year we have supported over 200 students with more than \$400,000 in scholarships and were honored by the National Scholarship Providers Association (NSPA) as the 2014 Scholarship Provider of the Year in the College and University category for excellence in program delivery. This practice supports their ability to persist toward completing a degree or certificate program; not surprisingly, over the last six program years, RRCC Foundation scholars have graduated and transferred at a rate greater than four times that of the general college-wide population at Red Rocks Community College.

With nearly 90% of the funds secured, the newly designed campus is scheduled to open its doors for fall 2016 classes!

## HONORING OUR VETERANS: *Daniels Brothers Memorial Endowment*

### **Veteran's Day Event – November 11, 2014**

Over 200 veterans and campus community members celebrated Veteran's Day at Red Rocks. The main ceremony and the POW/MIA ceremony were held at the Lakewood Campus in the Grand Foyer and Learning Commons. After a welcome by Red Rocks leadership, members of the campus community were treated to a bugler and bagpipes. This year's presentation was especially significant because ten Quilts of Valor were presented to RRCC student veterans. We thanked our student veterans for their service with packages containing t-shirts, stickers, and food.

### **Veteran Students Gap Funding Program**

Thanks to the foresight of Ron and Sonia Daniels, the Daniels Brothers Memorial Endowment was able to assist student veterans in need this year through the Veteran Students Gap Funding Program. The Veteran Students Gap Funding Program offers short-term loans to student veterans for the time period in between when they start class and their funding becomes available. Ten student veterans were supported in purchasing books required for their college classes. The average cost for books per student veteran was \$305 and the total amount used was \$3,055. Now, with the availability of established funding, we expect that the program will grow and we will see increased usage.


