Responsibilities

Teach a variety of courses in academic and technical theatre. Supervise the Theatre Lab Coordinator, production personnel and part-time, non-student hourly employees in Theatre and Dance. Supervise part-time faculty in Theatre Arts, Theatre Technology, Dance, and select Film & Video Technology courses. Serve as the Producing Director of RRCC Theatre productions, dance concerts and other special events as needed. Monitor budgets and participate in purchasing as needed. Supervise Career and Technical Education (CTE) Theatre Technology program in maintaining positive CTE program status and updating/revising CTE Theatre Technology curriculum, degrees, and certificates as needed.

Maintain equivalent full-time teaching load. Conduct curriculum planning, development, delivery and review. Recruit, advise and retain students. Hold regular office hours. Participate in departmental governance and assume departmental duties as needed. Select and mentor part-time instructors. Participate in departmental, divisional, and college-wide professional development activities and committees. Demonstrate sensitivity to different learning styles. Serve as a liaison between Red Rocks Community College and the community. Fulfill the teaching, professional development and service obligations of full-time faculty.

Qualifications

Minimum Qualifications: A master's degree in Theatre Arts or related field with at least 18 graduate hours in Theatre from a fully accredited institution. At least one year of experience teaching Theatre Arts

in a community college setting. Must have a current CTE vocational credential in Theatre Technology (or be eligible to secure the necessary vocational credential according to State and College requirements within one year). A strong commitment to effective teaching and to the learner-centered philosophy. A strong commitment to creating an environment, which fosters inclusiveness and diversity. Knowledge of, interest in, and ability to use technology-assisted and online delivery.

Preferred Qualifications: Significant experience in successfully producing, directing, managing and designing, especially for theatre productions and other performing arts events such as dance concerts. Two years of experience teaching a variety of courses in academic Theatre Arts and Theatre Technology programs at a community college. Experience teaching in alternative formats/non-traditional programs. Teaching or training experience in a higher education environment. Experience integrating technology into the classroom setting.
