Two New Allied Health Certificates at RRCC

To complete these certificates through Red Rocks Community College, applicants must have completed NUA 101 and NUA 170 and be Nurse Aid Certified through the State of Colorado. These certificates will be available starting **Fall Semester 2014**, but the required courses are available now! *Home Health Aide Certificate - Coming Fall 2014*

This certificate is designed to provide Certified Nurse Aides with additional training and knowledge on how to assist the elderly, sick and disabled, and to maintain their safety, health and independence in the comfort and convenience of their own homes.

Required Courses (now available):

- NUA 105 - Home Health Aide Theory
- NUA 180 - Home Health Aide Internship
- Hospice Aide Certificate - Coming Fall 2014

This certificate summarizes the history, philosophy, goals and objectives of end of life care and provides Certified Nurse Aides additional training and knowledge on how to assist terminally ill patients with their personal care requirements while maximizing comfort and quality of life.
