Celebrate Deaf Awareness

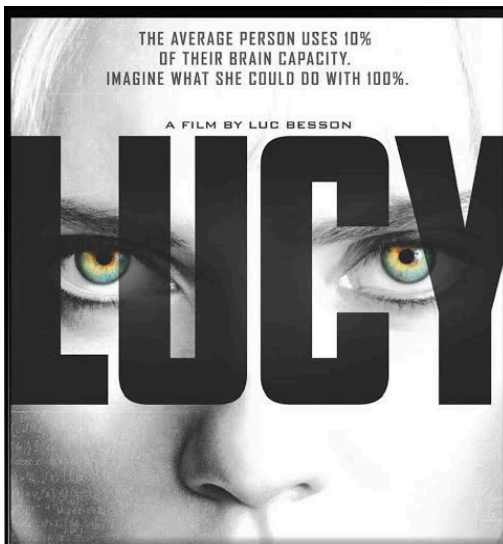
