To complete these certificates through Red Rocks Community College, applicants must have completed NUA 101 and NUA 170 and be Nurse Aid Certified through the State of Colorado. These certificates will be available starting Fall Semester 2014, but the required courses are available now! Home Health Aide Certificate - Coming Fall 2014

This certificate is designed to provide Certified Nurse Aides with additional training and knowledge on how to assist the elderly, sick and disabled, and to maintain their safety, health and independence in the comfort and convenience of their own homes.
