For Medical emergencies please provide:

★ The exact location of the emergency (room number and / or area of building)

★ What the nature of the emergency is? Example: Person is having a seizure

★ Your name and phone number

★ Please stay on the line with dispatch until emergency personnel arrive

★ Any changes to the persons condition while you are on the line with us

For any perceived threats or aggressive behavior:

★ The exact location

What is the person(s) doing? Are they still there?

Your name and phone number

★ Is this going on now?

★ Are any weapons involved/or any weapons visible? ★ What does the person (s) look like? (gender,

race, clothing, distinguishing features) This is very important in case the person leaves

your area before our officers arrive. ★ If possible, please stay on the line with dispatch until Campus Police arrives

handle all emergency calls. Please do not hesitate to contact us for any perceived threat or suspicious

person / incidents.
