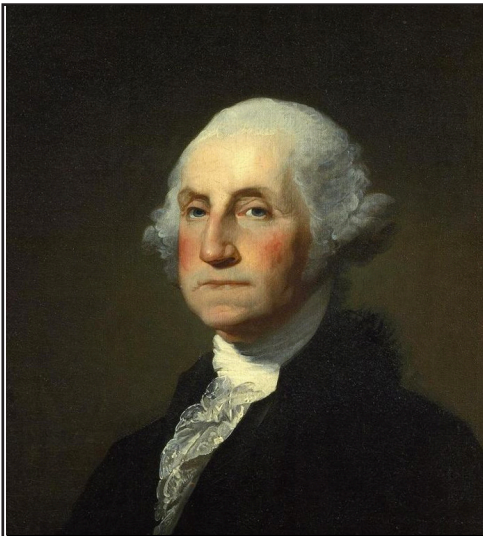

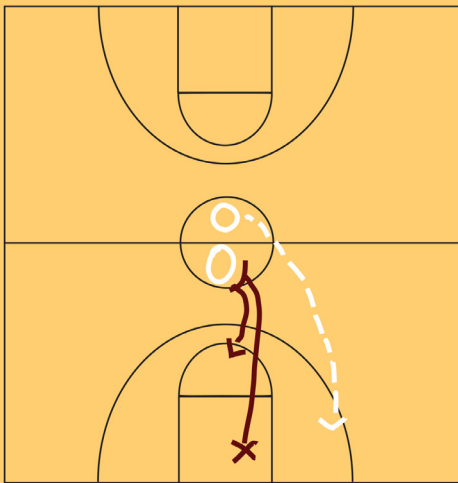

Tips for Intervening:

- Approach everyone as a friend
 - Do not be antagonistic
 - Avoid using violence
 - Be honest and direct whenever possible
 - Recruit help if necessary
 - Keep yourself safe
