## ASSET or DACA Students

This information is about Colorado ASSET/DACA classification, which allows eligible students without documentation to pay in-state, rather than out-of-state tuition, as well as receive the College Opportunity Fund stipend at Red Rocks Community College.

For ASSET status students, you will need to:

- Have attended high school for three years immediately before you graduated from a Colorado high school
- Be admitted to a participating college within twelve months of graduating from a Colorado high school
- Sign an affidavit, if you are not legally present in the U.S., saying that you are currently seeking or will seek legal status as soon as you are eligible.

For DACA status students, you will need to:

- have graduated from a Colorado high school or took the GED in Colorado prior to September 1, 2013
- weren't accepted or attending college within twelve months of graduation
- document eighteen (18) months of being physically present in Colorado on a continuous basis.
- Two documents are required.

Below are the documents the Federal Government is accepting for Deferred Action students or DACA students:

- If you are under 23 and single, you can submit a copy of your parents' lease, rental agreement or deed to their home where you reside in Colorado. If you have your own place, you can submit your lease or rental agreement or deed to a home you own.
- You can submit proof of employment such as a letter from your employer as to dates of employment or you can submit two years of Colorado income taxes being filed.
- You can submit a copy of your Employment Authorization Card.
- You can submit a copy of your Colorado ID or Colorado driver's license for the past 18 months or more.
- Two years of Colorado motor vehicle registration forms
- You can submit recent high school or college transcripts where you have attended for the past eighteen (18) months or more
