#### Winter is Here, Please Volunteer!

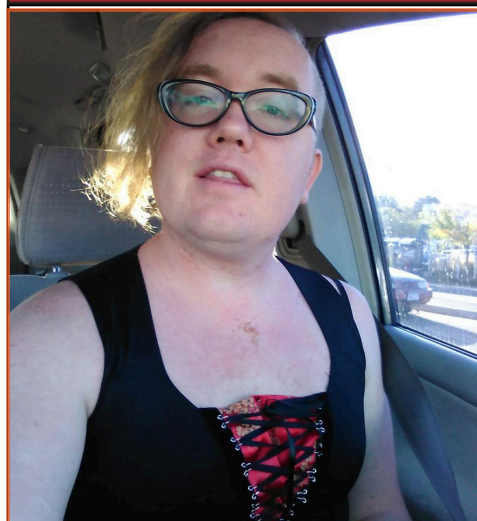
