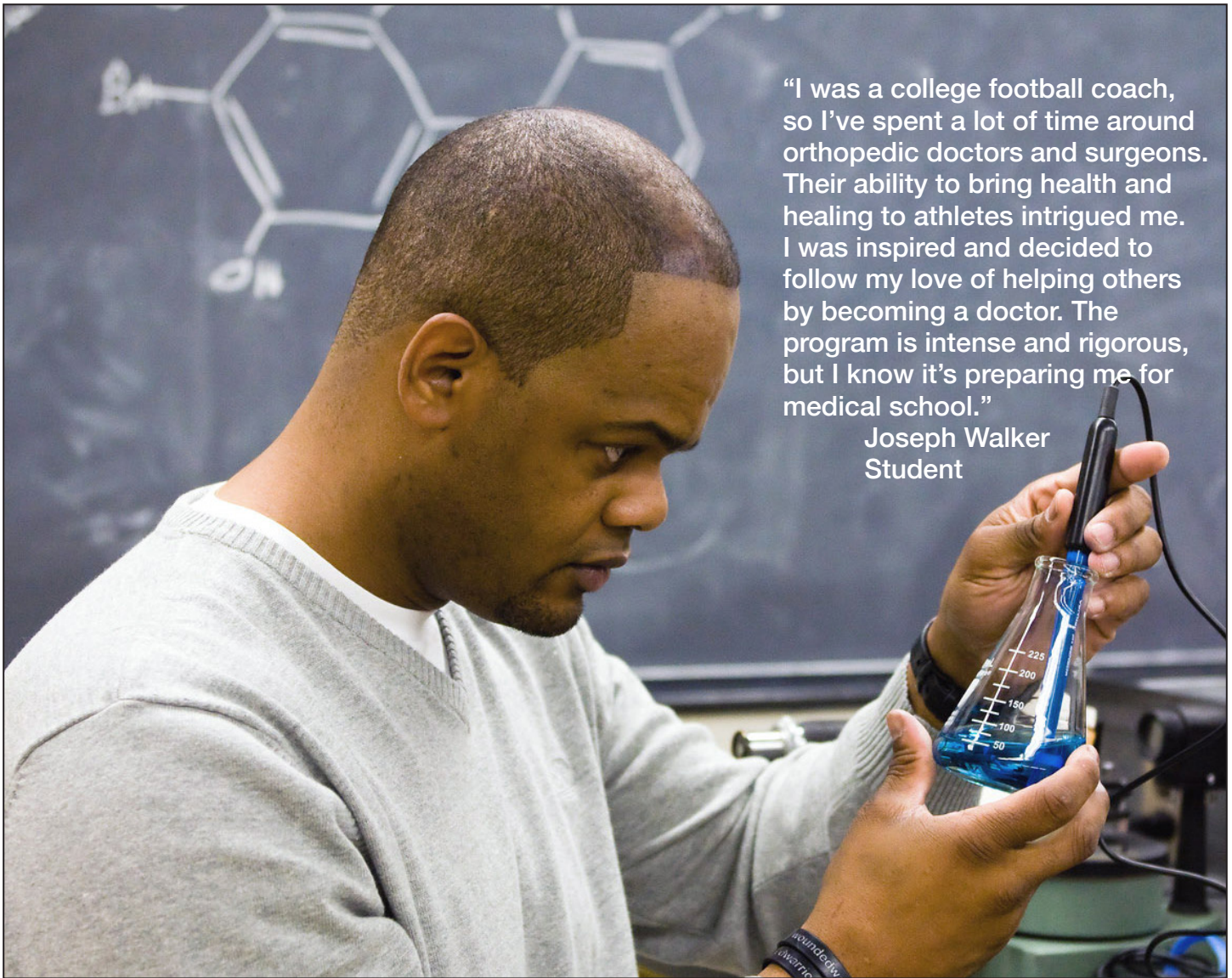


Post-Baccalaureate Health Professions Info Session
