Summary

The Veteran Outreach and Recruitment Specialist; is responsible for conducting outreach efforts to the military veteran community within Red Rocks Community College service area, as well as assisting families and prospective students to ensure that they receive accurate information and assistance through the admission process. They will communicate primarily, but not exclusively, to the student veteran community.

Responsibilities

Develop relationships with the service area communities to promote the benefits of RRCC, including educational programs, campus events, and scholarships as well as projecting an effective and consistent image of RRCC.

Create a pipeline with opportunities for prospective Veteran students to include their families, military friendly organizations, veteran centers and local military bases.

Disseminate college and program material to prospective and/or continuing Veteran students utilizing presentations on and off campus such as fairs/events, community agency meetings and military friendly organizations.

Coordinate day-to-day outreach activities that include responding to inquiries and communicating with prospective Veteran students.

Identify Veteran populations; develop visitation schedules, meet with prospective students to discuss college programs and answer questions concerning enrollment procedures, expectations and/or student life.

Plan, organize and staff special events on campus, including but not limited to, orientations, open houses, large group visits and presentations for community organizations and school partners.

Collaborate with RRCC Veteran Support Services to ensure communication between departments, students and staff.

Collect data and prepare reports that document activities and other information.

Assist with the development of marketing materials for the promotion of programs and services offered by the college to Veteran students.
