Summary

The position is for a full-time, one (1) year position for a multimedia specialist/videographer for Red Rocks Community College. The videographer will be responsible for defining and generating photography and video that conveys Red Rocks in a direct, authentic, creative and captivating way. The position will include creating storyboards, creating original videos, editing and producing videos and slideshows, photo essays or individual assignments that capture unique aspects of what it feels like to be at Red Rocks Community College.

Responsibilities

Responsible for all video, audio, and motion graphic production, including concepting, storyboarding, planning, shooting, organization and lighting of video shoots, creating graphics, editing, color correction, compression and encoding of videos, and digital asset management.

Edits all videos (and all other post-production tasks) which includes reviewing footage, rough cuts, audio adjustment, color correction, and final editing using Premiere, Final Cut Pro, After Effects, and/or other industry standard software.

Collaborates with Marketing Department to ensure consistency with Red Rocks core messaging and branding, as well as any department goals and objectives. This includes helping to develop and maintain a vision and voice for each brand.

Completes other projects and responsibilities as assigned by the Director of eLearning and Director of Student Outreach and Retention, Student Success.

Provides mentoring and training for Red Rocks team members as needed in both audio and video production.

- Ability to create storyboards and scripts that depict customer's vision.
- Must possess strong collaboration and interpersonal skills with the ability to accept input from other Red Rocks team members.
- Must have practical knowledge of audio and video signals digital characteristics, compressions, and conversion techniques; streaming technologies; file formats; and display devices.
- Must have practical knowledge of video composition principles and techniques such as framing, lighting, optics, perspectives, layering, keying, and sound design.
- Must be highly organized with the ability to prioritize and coordinate multiple work activities to meet critical deadlines.
- Can edit linear and non-linear video on both PC and Mac Platforms.
- Knowledge of open and closed captioning for the hearing impaired.
- Arranging music and capturing narration and editing for final.
