May 17	 End of spring semester student employment All student employment is terminated as of this date. Work-study employees who are not continuing at RRCC after spring may not work after May 7th.
May 18	 First day of summer semester student employment All new and returning students must be registered for six credit hours in the summer academic semester to be eligible for student employment. Student employees registered for fall semester courses only (without summer registration) will be required to contribute to a TIAA IRA. Beginning of summer semester work-study eligibility. Students must have a minimum of 6 credit hours, as well as work-study eligibility, in spring, summer, and fall semesters.
