General Rules:

- Launch weapons will be inspected for safety. If deemed unfit the team will be disqualified.
- No parts other than the projectile may come disconnected from the device at any time. Components must be securely attached prior to participating in the competition.
- If the device becomes inoperable or unsafe, it will be removed from the competition. If this were to happen, the team's current score becomes their final score.
- The competition is being held outdoors, factor such as rain or wind may affect outcomes. We're going to play anyway.
- These rules are subject to change at any time without the agreement of all teams in the competition, or at the discretion of the judge.
- Any teams found to be in violation of these rules will be disqualified from the competition.
- Costumes will be HIGHLY encouraged.

Contest Guidelines

- Individuals or teams may compete.
- Competitors must be Red Rocks Community College students.
- Teams must appoint a team leader/contact person.
- All competitors must register their device before Tuesday, October 27th.
- Safety is of utmost concern. Please test your device to the range you are competing for.
- No part of the device can extend over 5 feet high.
- Materials are the team's responsibility. Accuracy of the device will be paramount.

Devices may be entered in one or more of the range categories:

- 100 Yards Field goal line to goal line Baseball
- 50 Yards Field goal to center field line Golf Ball
- 10 feet (Table Top) Marble

Competition Rules:

- Devices will be allowed two test shots to get lined up.
- Devices in the 50yd and 100yd category will have three shots at a ground target, a pumpkin on a 6ft by 8ft plywood sheet, and be scored based on accuracy.
 - Scoring will be based on:
 - 1 point hitting the plywood sheet
 - 2 points hitting the 3ft diameter circle in the middle of the plywood sheet
 - 3 points Hit the pumpkin in the middle of the circle
- Devices in the 10ft category will be shooting at a bull's eye painted on a pumpkin:
 - Scoring will be based on:
 - 1 point hitting the outer ring of the bull's eye
 - 2 points hitting the inside ring of the bull's eye
 - 3 points hitting the bull's eye

Prizes will be awarded for the highest score in each category and to the contestant/team with the best costume.
