## Information and Frequently Asked Questions

1. Only degree-seeking students who meet the eligibility requirements are invited to join our chapter. These are:
  - Currently enrolled at RRCC in college-level courses
  - A minimum 3.5 cumulative GPA
  - Completed 12 credits at RRCC (**100 level classes and above**)
  - Are degree-seeking (AA, AS, AAS, AGS)
2. An invitation will be e-mailed to eligible students at **college-issued email addresses**, the week of August 29<sup>th</sup>.
3. **Students may ONLY accept membership on-line and pay with a credit card, but they must have the passcode that was included in their invitation.**
4. **Deadline to be included in the fall induction is Thursday, October 13<sup>th</sup> at 5:00 p.m.**
5. New member information meetings are not mandatory but will provide helpful information to those considering joining. The same session is held at three different times.

6. The Induction Ceremony is not mandatory, but attendance is encouraged. Families and friends are invited although young children may find it difficult to remain still. There is no cost, but **members need to sign up**. This is a formal ceremony and most people dress up a bit.
