Graduates are eligible to sit for the ARRT certification exam in Magnetic Resonance Imaging, RT(MR). The program offers online coursework and flexible clinical internship opportunities to assist the working Technologist in achieving certification. Admission to the certificate program is through a competitive selection process.

RTE 2055 Multiplanar Sectional Imaging - 2 credits

In addition, applicants must be in good standing with the ARRT and be RT(R) registered.

Minimum of meeting the structured education requirement and 125 completed competencies needed to sit for the ARRT MR exam and program completion.
