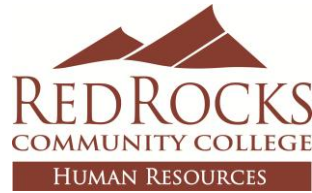


Student Employment Position Announcement

You must also be eligible for student employment (enrolled in a minimum of six (6) credit hours for the semester during which you will be working) and be awarded work-study through Red Rocks Community College to apply.
