

Important Dates for Student Employment – FALL 2017

Date	Significant Event
August 4	Final day of summer student employment <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - All student employment is terminated as of this date
August 5	First day of fall semester student employment <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Work-Study begins - All new and returning students must be registered for six credit hours in the fall academic semester to be eligible for student employment
August 5 – 18	Semester Interim <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Student employees may work up to 28 hours per week - Check with your org owner before increasing student workloads
August 19	All student employees must return to 20 hours per week
August 21	15 week classes begin
September 2 – 4	Labor Day Weekend <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - No Classes, both campuses closed - No student or hourly work without pre-authorization
September 6	Drop Cutoff date – Last day to drop 15 week classes <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Last day to initiate a tuition refund - Tuition is due. Late fees begin accruing 09.07.17
October 17	All College Development Day – No Classes
November 20 – 26	Fall Break – No Classes
November 23	Thanksgiving Holiday – Both Campuses Closed <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - No student or hourly work without pre-authorization
December 1	Student hiring begins for spring semester <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - HR begins accepting Renewal/New Hire requisitions for spring semester employees.
December 12	End of 15 week fall classes
December 9 – 22	Semester Interim <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Student employees may work up to 28 hours per week - Check with your org owner before increasing student workloads
December 22	End of fall semester student employment
December 23 – Jan 2	Winter Holiday <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - No Classes, both campuses closed - No student or hourly work without pre-authorization
