## **CPR for the Healthcare Professional**

### **American Heart Association**

#### **Objectives**

Through Skill practice and written evaluation the student will:

- Demonstrate an ability to recognize a cardiac emergency and respond appropriately.
- Demonstrate an ability to perform adequate compressions and ventilations on an unresponsive patient: adult, child and/ or infant; one and two person.
- Demonstrate an ability to recognize and handle a choking emergency
- Airway management
- AED use

#### **Course information**

This course follows the American Heart Association (AHA) course requirements:

- Video driven course content
- Guided skill practice in CPR and AED use
- 25 question written evaluation with score 85% or better, 3 attempts allowed

#### **Course completion requirements**

- Demonstrate to instructor a competence in performing all required skills listed in course objectives.
