Transfer Recruitment Information**

- Admissions Information for 2007-2008
 - The deadline for fall admission was July 1, 2007.
 - Applications are being accepted for the spring 2008 semester.
 - The deadline for spring 2008 is December 1, 2007.
 - Mathematic Requirement – college algebra or equivalent
 - Admissions Guarantee – AA or AS from Colorado Community College

- Changes for Fall 2008
 - Colorado State University is becoming a common application institution.
 - Students may apply via paper, CSU web site or the Common Application web site – we prefer for students to apply online.
 - Applications will **require** an essay and at least one letter of recommendation from an academic source (counselor, instructor, etc.)
 - Priority Filing Application Date for transfer students is moving to May 1 for fall admission
 - Enrollment Deposit will begin for Fall 2008 admits

- Scholarships
 - Phi Theta Kappa – June 1 Deadline (renewable)
 - \$2000 resident – 10 awards
 - \$6000 non-resident – 10 awards
 - Ram Transfer Scholarship – June 1 Deadline (renewable)
 - \$1000 resident – 25 awards
 - \$5000 non-resident – 25 awards
 - Griffin Foundation - March 1 Deadline
 - First Generation – March 1 Deadline
 - Departmental – varies, contact department

- Mathematics Requirement
 - College Algebra or higher level transferable math with a C- or better (Calculus, Pre-Calculus, Trigonometry, etc.) **-or-**
 - Survey of Algebra or equivalent with a B- or better
 - See the Course Applicability System (CAS) to verify transferability of courses <http://www.colostate.edu/Depts/Registrar/>
 - May also take online Math Placement Exam to satisfy admissions requirement, will still need to take math course for credit at CSU <http://www.math.colostate.edu/placement/placement.shtml>
 - If student has completed an AA or AS degree at Colorado Community College with a 2.0 or above, math requirement is satisfied (AGS, AAS does not qualify)
