

Daniels College of Business Articulation Agreement

*For students entering DU the academic year 2007-2008
(this includes Summer Quarter 2007)*

The University of Denver has a Business Core Curriculum required of all students pursuing a BSBA or BSACC degree. All students complete courses in the following areas: Accounting, Business Information Technologies, Statistics, Business Law, Marketing, Economics, Business Technical Writing and a one-year foreign language requirement. It is the responsibility of the student to be aware of the specific requirements of the desired degree.

This agreement enables students enrolled at any of the Colorado Community Colleges to take courses at those institutions to be used in completing the Business Core Requirements at the University of Denver. For courses to be transferable, a grade of "C" or better must be achieved in the course. For students majoring in accounting, a grade of "B" or better must be received in each Accounting Principles course in order to be transferable. Courses will be transferred on an equivalent basis to allow for differences in the quarter and semester systems. (One semester hour is counted as 1.5 quarter hours.)

The following indicates the courses that can be transferred into the University of Denver's Business core and related business requirements:
