Tutors Without Borders Lesson Plan

Measurable Outcomes Addressed by TWB Plan

- *Recognize and analyze selected works and themes of western culture
- *Analyze and objectively criticize different values, themes and methods evident in the works under discussion
- *Write and speak logically about the humanities

Tutor Visit I

Art Analysis Exercise and Assignment

MKB: Briefly discuss elements of art analysis

Tutor: Describe descriptive writing

Exercise: Each student pair receives an image of a modern work of art (works that are well known such as Van Gogh's - Starry Night, Munch - The Scream, Lange - Migrant Mother, etc.) and writes description.

Visit II and III Research Essay

English Tutor - discussion of analytical writing and documentation

Look at examples of analysis in art journals (bring in from library)

English or Library Tutor - How to look up art journals and peer reviewed articles.

Each student selects a work of art from the period studied in HUM 1 (Paleolithic, Mesopotamian, Chinese, Indian, Greek, or Roman) and researches the general time period and the individual work of art

Assignment: a 2-3 page essay that requires references to sources, own interpretation of work, and documentation. Tutors will work on drafts in class.
