Objectives

Through Skill practice and written evaluation:

- Demonstrate an ability to recognize a cardiac emergency and respond appropriately.
- Demonstrate an ability to perform adequate compressions and ventilations on an unresponsive patient
- Demonstrate an ability to recognize and handle a choking emergency

Course information

- American Heart Association (AHA) course requirements
 - Video driven course content
 - Guided skill practice
 - 20 question written evaluation with score 85% or better

Course requirements

- Purchase or have access to AHA Healthcare provider manual
- Participate in whole class by:
 - Viewing and performing skills demonstrated on video
 - Participate in all class activities
- Demonstrate to instructor a competence in performing skills
- Pass written test with grade of 85% or better (AHA requirement)

Grading policies

- Grade based on skills (P/F) and on written exam
- Written exam graded 90-100% on first attempt: A
 - 80-90% on first attempt: B
 - <85% must take test again (AHA requirement)
 - 85-100% on second attempt: B
 - <85% requires remediation at instructors discretion: C
- Students passing the test, demonstrating an inability to perform skills D
- Failure to pass test and perform skills adequately, after remediation F
