

Direct PLUS Loan Application (Parent)

The Federal Direct PLUS loan is available to parents of dependent students who wish to borrow funds to assist with their child's education. Parents eligible to apply for the PLUS loan must be a contributor on the student's FAFSA.

Processing Steps:

- 1. The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) needs to be completed at https://studentaid.gov/
- 2. The student will be offered all available aid after their FAFSA is received and their file is complete. This can include but is not limited to: grants, loans, and/or work-study.
 - a. All offered aid must be accepted or declined before a PLUS loan can be processed.
- 3. The parent borrower must complete a credit check at https://studentaid.gov
- 4. If the loan is approved, the parent borrower must complete a **Master Promissory Note** (MPN)* and possibly PLUS Entrance Counseling* at studentaid.gov.
- If the loan is denied, the student may request additional unsubsidized (interest-bearing)
 loan funds through the RRCC Financial Aid Office. The parent may also secure an endorser
 or appeal the decision and submit the information to the Department of Education at
 https://studentaid.gov

*FSA ID:

You are required to have an FSA ID to complete the FAFSA, sign your MPN, and complete Entrance counseling (if required). To obtain your FSA ID, visit https://studentaid.gov.

*Master Promissory Note (MPN):

An MPN must be completed by the parent borrower for the PLUS loan to pay into your student's school account. To complete the PLUS loan MPN, use your FSA ID to log into https://studentaid.gov.

*Entrance Counseling:

If you are approved for a PLUS loan after initially being denied, either with an endorser or after an appeal, you as the parent borrower will need to complete PLUS Entrance Counseling. To complete PLUS Entrance Counseling, use your FSA ID to log into https://studentaid.gov.
