- ✓ Intuit Personal Finance certification Microcredential holders are eligible to sit for the Intuit Personal Finance certification exam, based on the Council for Economic Education (CEE) and JumpStart national financial education standards. This industry-recognized certification validates the mastery of personal finance skills.
- ✓ Eligibility for Prior Learning Assessment Students can apply to the Credit for Prior Learning (CPL) program at 13 community colleges in Colorado. CPL provides academic credit toward an associate degree or certificate.
- ✓ Workforce preparedness for careers in banking and personal finance.
