Database Searching General

<u>Communication & Mass Media Complete</u> [RRCC Library Access] - Core database for communication studies. In this database, you'll find the top tier journals in a variety of sub-disciplines for communication.

<u>Psychology and Behavioral Sciences</u> [RRCC Library Access] - peer-reviewed journals from the field of psychology; many interpersonal communication topics (i.e. group communication, relationship communication or family communication dynamics) covered in this databases

<u>JSTOR</u> [RRCC Library Access] - peer-reviewed articles and books on a wide variety of topics, including communication and linguistics

• Use the limiters on the left-hand side "Communication" and/or "Linguistics" to limit to more communication-related content - look for terms such as "group dynamics", "interpersonal relationships", "health communication", etc.
