Dear Student,

I am reaching out to you with some information regarding the Satisfactory/Unsatisfactory grading policy, as it relates to the current semester.

Satisfactory / Unsatisfactory is similar to Pass/Fail. If you earned a grade of "A" or "B", you probably do not want to pursue this option. If you are receiving a "C" or better, you can request your grade be changed to "Satisfactory." If you are getting a grade below a "C", you can request your grade be changed to "Unsatisfactory." Satisfactory and Unsatisfactory grades do not count in your GPA, but requesting an "Unsatisfactory" grade in place of a "D" grade can negatively impact your eligibility for financial aid. If you are doing well in most courses, Satisfactory / Unsatisfactory could be used to prevent one class from bringing down your GPA.

Requests for S or U grades will only be accepted after grades have officially posted for the Spring 2020 semester. You may submit your electronic request through The Rock student portal. The S/U Grade Request form will be on the Student tab under My Student Stuff. You will have between May 18 - 26 to complete the S/U grade change request form. Your Pathway Advisor and Financial Aid (if applicable) will follow up with you to complete the process after you have filled out the formstack. Please continue to check your RRCC college issued email for any updates.
