## Earn your Associate of Applied Science Degree in Law Enforcement!

**If you are looking to advance your career in Law Enforcement**, earning a college degree can help you grow your career in broader directions. While entry-level positions and many police officer roles do not require a college degree, education is critical if you want to advance in your career and move into a leadership role. Red Rocks Community College (RRCC) can accept the education and training you have already received and apply it toward an Associate of Applied Science Degree in Law Enforcement. Out of the required 60 credit hours for the degree, students may apply up to 45 credits from prior learning outside of RRCC. Regardless of prior credit, students still must complete a minimum of 15 credit hours through RRCC to earn the degree. If you have taken previous college credit courses, RRCC can evaluate your transcript and apply it toward your 45 credit hours if those courses meet our requirements. The chart below shows examples of how students can receive credit for their prior learning.
