





APA In-text citation example:

Ellis (2017) explains the basics of how rational emotive behavior therapy works, "It encourages self-effort and the resulting experience of greater empowerment so that clients can rightly claim to take responsibility for, and create, their emotions" (p. 272).

APA Bibliographic/End-of-text citation example for an academic article:

Ellis, D. J. (2017). Rational emotive behavior therapy and individual psychology. *Journal Of Individual Psychology*, 73(4), 272-282.
